RULES AND REGULATIONS REGARDING PARTICIPATION IN THE CONCERTS OF THE 24TH CHAMBER MUSIC FESTIVAL "ARSENAL NIGHTS", ORGANIZED BY THE FOUNDATION FOR MUSICAL CULTURE OF WROCŁAW WRATISLAVIA, DURING THE SARS-2 VIRUS EPIDEMIC IN POLAND

§ 1 GENERAL PROVISIONS

- 1. The present *Rules and Regulations*, specifying in detail the rules for the participation of listeners in the events, apply during concerts taking place within the framework of the 24th Chamber Music Festival ARSENAL NIGHTS organized by the Foundation for Musical Culture of Wrocław WRATISLAVIA with its seat in Wrocław (53-615), ul. Słubicka 29-33.
- 2. The purchase of a ticket, entry and presence of persons at the venue of the concert is equivalent to the acceptance of, and compliance with the following *Rules and Regulations*.
- 3. The Organizer reserves the right to cancel the concert, change its date, place, time, or change the repertoire of the Festival (programme or artists) for any reason.
- 4. The Organizer reserves the right to cancel the concert if the event does not take place for reasons attributable to the Performers, in which case the participants are entitled to a refund of the cost of the ticket.
- 5. In the event of changing the date of the concert, the place where the concert is to take place, or changes to the programme of the event, the participant decides whether to attend the concert or request a refund of the cost of the ticket.
- 6. Persons in possession of a valid ticket are authorised to participate in the concert.
- 7. The admission ticket entitles to enter the concert once, while the Carnet entitles to take part in 7 concerts, including: one selected concert by Magda Umer (on 1 or 2 July 2021) and one selected concert on 4 July 2021 (at 6 pm or 8.30 pm).

§ 2 RULES OF PARTICIPATION

- 1. The person in possession of the admission ticket declares that if s/he develops symptoms of COVID-19 infection, s/he will refrain from attending the concert.
- 2. The person using the admission ticket declares that s/he has not been abroad in countries with COVID-19 cases during the 2 weeks prior to the concert date.
- 3. The person using the admission ticket declares that, to the best of their knowledge, during the 2 weeks prior to the concert date, neither s/he nor anyone in constant contact with her/him is or has been infected with COVID-19, nor is / has been in quarantine or under epidemiological supervision in connection with the COVID-19 disease.
- 4. The person using the admission ticket declares that, to the best of their knowledge, during their participation in the concert, they do not experience symptoms of infection, such as: cough, fever, runny nose, rash, muscle aches, sore throat, and other unusual symptoms.
- 5. The ticket purchased by the participant may not be used in advertising and promotional campaigns (including contests or lotteries/sweepstakes) or for any other commercial purposes.
- 6. Resale or attempt to resell a ticket at a price higher than that printed on the ticket, or using the ticket in an unauthorized promotion, invalidates the ticket without the refund of the purchase price.
- 7. During the SARS-CoV-2 virus epidemic in Poland, the Organizer requests the members of the audience to arrive at the concert venue no later than 15 minutes before the start of the event.
- 8. After the concert has started, the Audience Service has the right to allow entry into the venue by late arrivals only after the first piece has finished.
- 9. We ask you to respect the rules of politeness and to dress in a decent manner.
- 10. During the concert, the Organizer requests the audience to maintain silence and to refrain from talking, drinking beverages and eating.

§ 3 SAFETY RULES

The Organizer reserves the right, in conjunction with all other provisions and directives, to the following:

- 1. Refuse entry to a ticket holder on the grounds of security.
- 2. At the entrance to the premises, the participant is required to present a valid ticket (pass, invitation) and to submit to the control by the Audience Service, to the extent specified in these Rules of Participation.
- 3. It is forbidden to bring onto the premises objects that may pose a direct threat to the safety of other participants, such as firearms, gas weapons, stun guns, gas throwers, knives, firecrackers, smoke candles, lasers, laser pointers, as well as objects that could be used as projectiles and any other similar items. similar.
- 4. It is forbidden to bring alcoholic beverages, intoxicants or psychotropic substances, explosives, pyrotechnic materials, fire-hazardous materials as well as glass, metal, or plastic containers, and umbrellas.
- 5. In the tent halls and within 2 metres around them, as well as in the interiors of the Arsenal, the use of open fire, the smoking of tobacco and the use of the so-called e-cigarettes is forbidden.
- 6. Persons in the state of insobriety do not have the right to enter the organized events despite possessing a valid admission ticket.
- 7. Bringing dogs, cats and other animals to the premises is prohibited, except for assistance dogs and guide dogs.
- 8. Persons who do not comply with the provisions of these *Rules and Regulations* and who do not comply with the instructions of the Audience Service will be removed from the premises without the right to a refund of the monetary equivalent for the purchased admission ticket.
- 9. The admission ticket expires upon leaving the premises and does not entitle the holder to re-enter the facility / event.

9 4 PROTECTION OF COPYRIGHT AND INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY

The Organizer reserves the right, in conjunction with all other provisions and directives, to the following:

- 1. Refuse permission to bring a camera, camcorder or other audio-video recording equipment to the concert venue and to use it during the concert (this does not apply to representatives of accredited media marked with an appropriate identifier).
- 2. Persons attempting to bring a camera, camcorder or other audio-video recording equipment to the concert venue will have to take into account the necessity to place the equipment in deposit, the cost of which is PLN 50.
- 3. During concerts, the use of cell phones is prohibited and their turn off is mandatory, as is the turn off of the sound signals in other electronic devices.

§ 5 FINAL PROVISIONS

- 1. Participation in the concert is tantamount to granting permission by the participants to the free-of-charge recording of their images (in particular photographing, filming) during their presence at the place and time of the concert and during the concert itself. The consent covers the use of the image(s) in the Organizer's materials for promotional, archival and information purposes.
- 2. In the concert venue, sanitary instructions are made available, among others regarding effective hand washing, wearing a mask and keeping a safe distance. Participants are requested to read the information materials and to comply with the rules.
- 3. It is recommended to maintain a distance of at least 1.5 metres between participants (this does not apply to families with children and care-providers of persons with disabilities).

- 4. The number of persons present at the concert site is limited in accordance with the recommendations of the sanitary inspectorate. Participants of the events are required to follow the instructions of the Audience Service staff in this regard.
- 5. Entry to the concert venue and participation in the concert is possible only whilst in possession of a valid ticket for this concert and if the participant has and uses a protective mask that covers the mouth and nose. Mouth and nose must be covered at all times during the concert.
- 6. When entering the concert venue, the entrants must disinfect their hands using their own disinfectants or those provided by the Organizer.
- 7. In matters not covered by these *Rules and Regulations* and relating to fire safety, the provisions apply that result from the Act of 24 August 1991 on fire protection and the Regulation of the Ministry of Interior and Administration of 21 April 2006 on fire protection of buildings, other structures and areas, provided respectively in the Journal Of Laws No. 80, item 536.
- 8. These *Rules and Regulations* shall apply as of 10.06.2021 for the duration in Poland of the state of epidemic in connection with SARS-CoV-2 virus infections, declared by the Regulation of the Minister of Health of 20 March 2020, and no longer than until 04.07.2021.
